

**Minimum Reporting requirements to Receive
A County Medal, Certificate, or Special Award for Record Books**

Levels of Recognition:

1. County Medal
 2. County Achievement Certificate
- LIMIT: Two (2) per year, any combination

Requirements for a **County Medal**:

1. Project Work – appropriate to age level
2. Use knowledge and skills learned in project work to inform or educate others
 - A. All work appropriate to age level. Example: Could be an exhibit, demonstration, speech or judging event.
3. Citizenship/Community Service – appropriate to age level.
4. Leadership – appropriate to age level.
5. All of the above must be reported in the form of the County Record Book.
6. To determine if works is “appropriate to age level”; refer to 4-H manual for that project.

Requirements for a **County Achievement Certificate**:

1. There was a good level of work reported in the record book, but the project needs to be more complete and show work in all of the main areas listed above.

Advanced Achievement, Citizenship, Leadership or Project Work:

1. Must have been in 4-H a minimum of 6 years
2. Must demonstrate continued growth in main project area while maintaining a high level of leadership and citizenship.
3. Must have previously received a medal in the same award category as a senior 4-H member.
