

2019 FAIR EXHIBITS OKLAHOMA HOME & COMMUNITY EDUCATION GROUPS

1. Only members of Beaver County Oklahoma Home & Community Education can make entries for their club in this Department.
2. Each Class will be judged as Blue, Red or White placing as deemed appropriate by the judge. Judge may give as many blue ribbons as desired. When all exhibits in one class are blue, a Cream of Crop must be chosen. Other Cream of the Crop ribbons are given at the discretion of the judge, limit to 1 ribbon per class. All classes may receive only 1 Cream of the Crop ribbon; Cream of Crop to be chosen as class is judged.
3. The prizes are based on the point system: Blue is 3 points, Red is 2 points, White is 1 point, and Cream of the Crop is 1 additional point.
4. Each group must have a full exhibit, with all 22 exhibits. All entries must have been completed within the last 2 years and never exhibited before. Items are to be handmade unless otherwise specified.
5. Premiums determined by Fair Board, subject to change:
First \$70.00
Second 65.00
Third..... 60.00
Fourth55.00
6. In case of a tie, according to the point system, the monies involved will be divided equally.
7. OHCE may have a Country Store booth. Items to be donated can be handmade, garden produce, or homemade food items.

2001 - CANNING/FOOD PRESERVATION EXHIBITS

Canned food must be sealed in a jar made specifically for home canning using a 2-piece lid. A new ring should be on the jar for judging. No Fancy Pack and No colored jars are allowed.

1. Salsa (1 pint) (1/2" head space)
2. Fruit Butter (1/4" head space), half-pint or pint jars
3. Fruit Leather, 2 pieces

2002 - CLOTHING EXHIBITS

4. Sleepwear or Loungewear
5. Baby Bib
6. Girl's T-shirt Dress

2003 - HOME FURNISHING EXHIBITS

7. Handiwork Article (fiber based medium)
8. Wreath, Handmade
9. Unfinished Quilt Block, any size

2004 - FOOD EXHIBITS (With Recipes)

All food exhibits should be exhibited on a paper plate when practical. Place in a zip-lock bag. No mixes – made from scratch with recipe.

10. Yeast Dinner Rolls, (3) (Standard – Not Machine)
11. 1-layer cake, 8-inch or 9-inch cake, not frosted
12. Muffins (3)
13. Fudge (3 pieces) any flavor

2005 - HORTICULTURE EXHIBITS

14. Theme Garden with minimum of 1 live plant
15. Wild Flower Specimen, 1 stalk (displayed in provided vase)
16. Fruit and/or Vegetable Display - Homegrown

2006 - CULTURAL ARTS

17. Community Project – Beaver Co OHCE Promotional Items for 1 county display
18. Photograph of Beaver County Landscape (5" x 7" or less) displayed on any size cardboard or poster board.
19. Handmade jewelry, 1 piece
20. Repurposed Item from a pair of denim jeans

21. Holiday Decoration, Handmade or from a Kit
22. Holiday Table Runner
