132 Blaine County 4th graders attended the first annual Blaine County Farm Safety Day on April 19, 2007. The children attended workshops on farm and home safety throughout the day. Classes attended were: Meth Awareness, Spit It Out; Grain Safety; Tractor Safety; Water Safety; Oil and Gas Well Safety; and gun Safety. A special guest was Smokey the Bear and friend who spoke on Fire Safety. Progressive Agriculture sponsored the day with t-shirts and bags. Local businesses and civic groups assisted with donations and volunteered.

## PARTICIPANT RESULTS:
