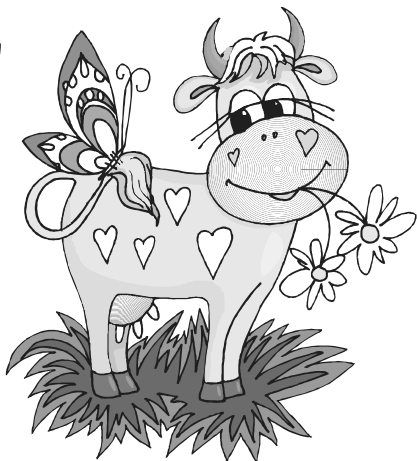
Come join the fun and excitement at the fair. There will be a lot for you to do and see. There are animals to see and games to play. You can even scramble for real **money!!**

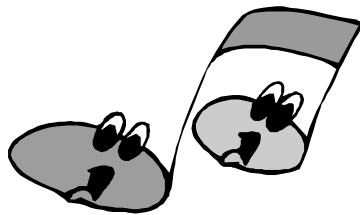

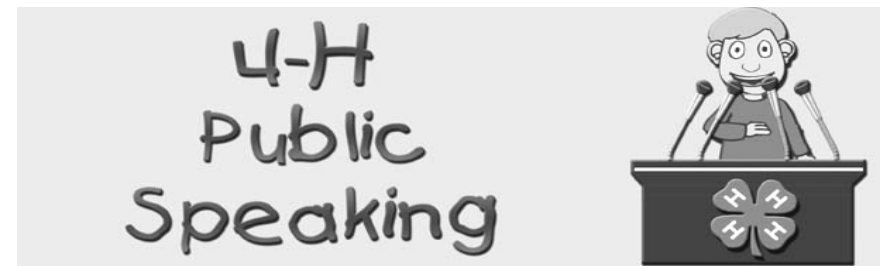
