Quicken Farm Recordkeeping

Many agriculture producers find it difficult to find a computer recordkeeping system that is both user friendly and reasonably priced. Canadian County OSU Extension will be offering a workshop on Quicken Farm Recordkeeping beginning at 9:30 a.m., Wednesday, February 20 at the Education Building on the fairgrounds in El Reno.

The cost of the workshop is \$25 per couple or participant. Each couple/participant will receive a Quicken notebook and CD-ROM with all the farm categories for the Quicken recordkeeping system.

This price does not include the Quicken software itself which can be purchased where computer software is sold. Also, if folks would like to bring their own personal laptop (which already has a version of Quicken loaded on it) they are welcome to do so.

Please ask friends and neighbor to come and learn the best, most economical farm recordkeeping system available. Dr. Damona Doye will be teaching the session along with our new District Ag Econ Specialist, Daniel Skipper.
