

KAY COUNTY FAIR

County Fair is an annual event designed for 4-H'ers to exhibit completed projects from past year's work. County Fair is held the second week in September each year. Workshops will be held prior to the fair in several projects.

Objectives:

- To teach 4-H members skills, leadership, and good citizenship skills.
- To offer an incentive for 4-H member participation in a project.
- To measure the degree of achievement.
- To make the public aware of 4-H.

Who Can Participate:

- Exhibitors must be nine years of age and a regularly enrolled member of 4-H 30 days prior to county fair.
- Exhibitors must meet requirements set forth in the Kay County Free Fair catalog.
- Exhibitors will be permitted to exhibit only exhibits that have been completed since last year's fair with the exception of house plants, leaf mounts, insects, and terrariums.
