

METEOROLOGY SCIENCE PROGRAM

This program is designed to increase students understanding of basic principles of meteorology and weather. Experimenting and learning about weather can be an interesting and educational experience for youth. The lesson materials differ in complexity and are designed for varied age levels. The instructor is encouraged to select materials which will best fit the class members age and interests.
