

NATIONAL DAIRY CONFERENCE

One Oklahoma 4-H member is selected to represent Oklahoma at the National 4-H Dairy Conference, held in conjunction with the World Dairy Expo, in Madison, Wisconsin in early October.

Objectives:

- To offer youth an educational experience which will provide a better understanding of the operations involved in the production, processing, marketing and use of dairy products as well as related fields.
- To provide a means by which various individuals and groups interested in the dairy industry and youth can have educational experience based on the developmental needs of youth.

Selection:

- Delegate is selected from Project Report Books submitted in state competition.
- Selection is based on achievement in the 4-H dairy project.

Specific Requirements:

- Must have a signed Code of Conduct (RAM form) agreement on file in the State 4-H Office prior to trip.
- Delegates violating the code of conduct may be sent home at their own expense.
- Members may attend National Dairy Conference only once.
