

## **PROJECT LEAD LEGAL EDUCATION AGAINST DELINQUENCY**

Project LEAD is a program targeted for sixth grade level students offering materials specifically directed toward the prevention of juvenile delinquency. LEAD utilizes a series of 14 "Teacher Directed" learning experiences that help young people "Put Themselves In The Other Person's Shoes". With the rapidly increasing problems of juvenile delinquency, vandalism, and associated problems of drug and alcohol abuse, this program strives to help young people before they are at great risk of getting into trouble with the legal system.
