

WAGON MASTERS

Wagon Masters is an entertaining game designed to teach young people in the 9-13 age group about money, markets and prices. A kit of 36 small wagons is the tool for teaching the basics of trading, use of money, supply and demand as well as inflation. Six lessons are outlined in the Teacher Guide. Wagon Masters is an active classroom program. Trades take place with meaningful exchange of ownership and "play money" changes hands as prices are the result of how much "play money" it takes to get the needed parts.

1. A kit of 36 small wagons, including wheels, hoops, axles, covers, and skins is provided. Students barter, trade and buy and sell the needed parts to make up the wagons.
