

4-H CAMP

Kay County 4-H camp is a program designed for all youth enrolled in the 4-H club program. Members learn through participation in workshops and recreation activities.

Camp is a wonderful opportunity for club members to meet new people and make new friends.

County Teen Leaders serving as camp counselors present workshops. Adult volunteers also provide supervision.

Camp is held at Lew Wentz Park, in Ponca City, during the summer. Watch the county newsletter for more details.

Usually begins on Monday and ends on Thursday evening with Family Night where all of the family is invited to attend for a special meal and program.

Camp costs each year will depend on number of participants, but generally will be from \$75-\$100. Must pre-register using form in 4-H newsletter.
