## Made in Oklahoma Coalition 4-H Recipe Contest

We are excited to announce a 4-H Recipe Contest with the Robert M. Kerr Food & Agricultural Products Center (FAPC) and Made in Oklahoma (MIO) Coalition. Contact the Extension office for guidelines and rules for the contest which is open to both Junior and Senior 4-H members and clubs .

4-H members across the state are encouraged to create recipes and products made with locally produced MIO Coalition products while completing the steps of service learning: preparation, action, reflection and celebration.

Two prizes of \$500 will be awarded, one for each junior and senior category. Both individual and club entries will be judged together. A group consists of 2-5 people. There can be no more than two groups, two individual entries or a combination of group and individual per club.

1. Junior – Grades 3-7 as of Sept. 1, 2018
2. Senior – Grades 8-12 as of Sept. 1, 2018
3. If the group has a combination of both age groups the submission will automatically default to the senior category.

All completed contest submission forms and photos **must be submitted by 5 p.m. on Feb. 15, 2019**. The entries must be emailed to [andrea.graves@okstate.edu](mailto:andrea.graves@okstate.edu).
